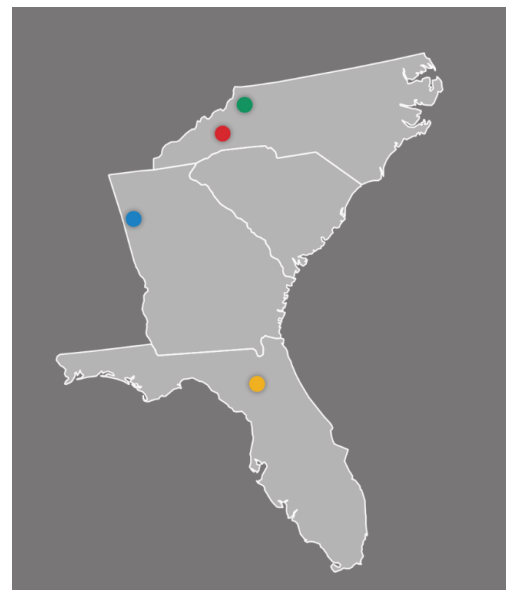

Standard rates apply to adult and family camps throughout registration season.

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT

We accept the following payment forms: Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express.

Registration Office must receive payment in full at least 2 weeks before your arrival.

We require a \$175 deposit per program for each person. **These deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.** Your registration is not considered complete until NovusWay receives your paid deposit.

MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT

Families with more than one child attending camp this summer are eligible for a sibling discount. After you register the first child at regular price all subsequent children will receive a \$35 discount. This discount only applies to children who live in the same household; it does not apply to any family camps or custom groups. This discount is applied automatically when you register. If you have any questions contact the registration office.

CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellation requests must be made in writing. Email to registration@novusway.org or mail to: NovusWay Ministries, 2049 Upper Laurel Dr, Arden, NC 28704.

Cancellations made 30 days or more from the program date are eligible for a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit of \$175.

Cancellations made less than 30 days notice but more than 10 days are eligible for a refund of 50% the program cost minus the non-refundable deposit of \$175.

Cancellations made within 10 days or less do not qualify for a refund.

In the event of illness or extenuating circumstances, NovusWay registration may make additional allowances.

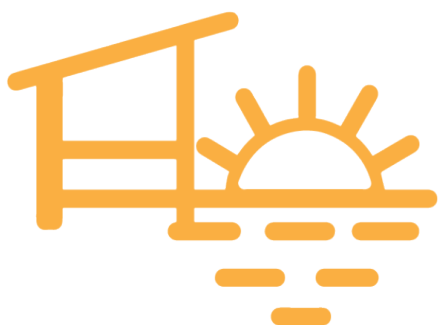
